INTRODUCTION

There is a whole world of exciting, fresh and diverse white wines in Argentina just waiting for you to discover them. White grapes are often grown at high altitude, giving them the intensity and freshness that makes them oh-so drinkable. Leading the charge is Torrontés, this grape variety is rarely found elsewhere around the world and the fresh, floral, spicy, aromatic notes make it perfect for accompanying food. Another style growing in popularity is white Malbec. Made from the classic red Malbec grape, it's harvested early and pressed gently to avoid colour and tannin extraction. A must-try if you're already a fan of the red! Meanwhile Cristóbal's Verdelho has recently made an interesting new addition to the Tanners range.

THE WINES

- 1. Gougenheim Torrontés, Uco Valley, Tupungato, Mendoza** Bin No: TW018
Beautifully balanced zippy white, without the over-perfumed character this variety can sometimes have. Lovely and zesty with refreshing grapefruit notes.
- 2. Cristóbal 1492 Verdelho, Mendoza** ^{NEW!} Bin No: TW027
This grape variety has made its way to Argentina from Madeira. Here it produces a lovely, easy, fresh and fruity wine, with some exotic fruit character and a delicious peachy finish. 
- 3. Las Pampas Chenin/Torrontés, Mendoza** Bin No: TW021
This wine treads the line perfectly between the tropical, rounded Chenin Blanc and floral crispness from the Torrontés grapes. Great value, everyday drinking wine.
- 4. Ojos del Sur Sauvignon Blanc, Patagonia** Bin No: TW024
A rich Sauvignon Blanc with lovely weight and density, some tropical fruit flavour with a delicious savoury note adding complexity, before a fine elegant finish.
- 5. Las Pampas White Malbec, Mendoza** ^{NEW!} Bin No: TW025
Soft and round with floral notes and attractive peachy fruit on the palate. Quite full but with enough freshness to give balance.  
- 6. Cristóbal 1492 Chardonnay, Mendoza** Bin No: TW014
An attractive nose of exotic fruits is followed on the palate by more peachy fruit. The palate is fresh and clean with generosity, the finish long and fine.
