



French Favourites Mixed Half Dozen

INTRODUCTION

Explore six French classics with this collection: Alsace whites are fabulous food wines, as too is Les Silex – a gem from Touraine. Journey further west for Sancerre's classic rosé, before heading to Gascony, for Tanners own label rosé. Our Rhône Red is juicy, crunchy red fruits and peppery spice, and lastly, enjoy a cru Beaujolais boasting silky juicy fruit.

THE WINES

1. Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Les Silex, Domaine Beauséjour

This estate is run by brothers Arnaud and Albéric Lechat. This is super, elegant Sauvignon Blanc with lovely weight of gooseberry fruit and a beautiful mineral element on the finish.

2. Dopff & Irion Pinot Blanc, Cuvée René Dopff, Alsace

A fresh, crisp wine to be savoured on its own or as an apéritif. Alsace excels at this style. The co-operative at Pfaffenheim, just to the south of Colmar, is an excellent source of pure, fruity, dry whites.

3. Tanners French Rosé, Côtes de Gascogne

Sourced from a family domaine in the Gers, this juicy, racy rosé has been a fantastic success since release. Vibrant summer fruits nose and a soft strawberry flavour mean one bottle isn't enough!

4. Sancerre Rosé, Firmin Dezat

The rosés of Sancerre are made from Pinot Noir, not so surprising as Sancerre is closer to Burgundy than to Muscadet! This dry rosé is deliciously light with strawberry fruit so is ideal as an apéritif or with a light meal.

5. Tanners Rhône Valley Red, Côtes du Rhône (organic)

Pretty nose of red summer fruits with some plump, creamy blue fruit notes. Medium-bodied, round and juicy with good volume and supple tannins, offering long flavours of peppery spices over crisp red fruit. Very enjoyable drinking.

6. Juliénas, Michel & Sylvain Tête, Domaine du Clos du Fief

A big, silky wine from this most charming region, shows lovely cassis and cherry fruit on the nose and palate. Juicy and long with a touch of spice on the finish.
