INTRODUCTION

Rosés have now firmly established their place on our tables and picnic rugs. Aided by some celebrity endorsements, Provence has capitalised royally, and you will note Tanners brand new **Provence** Rosé has just been launched (details in the Summer Tanners News, in case you missed it!) but there are plenty of great alternatives from around the vinous globe including from these shores. For those looking for a little more flavour in their rosé then **Spain**, in the form of Paso Primero and the New World, where Tom Doran is producing some super characterful rosé in **South Africa**, can offer great choices. There are also fine examples from the Mediterranean coast such as **Corbières**, where Cendrillon makes an exquisite pink, and Sète where the uber fashionable region of **Picpoul** has its own rosé, Piquepoul – the former the name of the appellation, the latter the grape! The trend has even reached these shores, where Folc sources grapes across the southwest of **England** from small family-run vineyards and blends them to create a very credible alternative to Provence's best. As we roll into summer, make sure you have stocked up on your favourite!


THE WINES

- 1. Piquepoul Rosé, Coteaux d'Enserune, Foncalieu, France** Bin No: MP0059B
The little known Piquepoul Noir, produces this beautifully delicate rosé with floral notes of rose petals, and lovely zesty fruit. Perfect for sipping in the sunshine.
- 2. Domaine La Cendrillon Minuit Rosé, Corbières, France (organic)** Bin No: MP0054B
An elegant but flavour-filled rosé with a beautiful colour. The nose is fresh and floral with notes of hibiscus and rose as well as citrus fruit. On the palate there are flavours of pink grapefruit and tangerines.
- 3. Tanners Provence Rosé, Côtes de Provence, France NEW!** Bin No: MP0002B
Pale and bright, this is a classic Provence rosé with expressive fruit aromas. A silky and broad palate is characterised by exotic flavours and complemented by a mineral freshness on the finish.
- 4. Doran Vineyards Rosie D Rosé, Voor Paardeberg, South Africa NEW!** Bin No: KP0003B
A refreshing rosé full of strawberry and raspberry fruit, pure pleasure in a glass and with a lower alcohol level to boot, achieved by spinning cone technology!
- 5. Paso-Primero Rosé, Somontano, Spain** Bin No: SP0007B
A full rosé with plenty of soft and ripe red fruits, strawberries and redcurrants. Fresh and easy for everyday drinking. Made by ex-Tanners employees, Tom and Emma Holt.
- 6. Folc Dry English Rosé, England** Bin No: HP0009B
A dry, fresh, and undeniably delicious English rosé made from an eclectic blend of seven grapes. An aromatic, floral nose is backed by wild strawberries, cranberries and a green apple note on the palate with a crisp, refreshing finish.
