INTRODUCTION

From sunny garden gatherings to evening al fresco dining, a bottle of rosé is a must-have addition to any summer table. The beauty of rosé lies in its crowd-pleasing character, gentle aromas and food matching potential. While the pale, crisp elegance of Provence and the Mediterranean coast produces a timeless favourite style, there is a whole world of rosé waiting to be explored.

THE WINES

1. Folc Dry English Rosé, England

Bin No: HP0009B

A dry, fresh, and undeniably delicious English rosé made from an eclectic blend of five grapes, hand harvested from Kent (69%) and Hampshire (31%) vineyards. An aromatic floral nose draws you in while flavours of wild strawberries and cranberries abound on the palate and a green apple note ensures a crisp, refreshing finish.

2. Castillo Monjardin Rosado del Alba, Navarra, Spain

Bin No: SP0010B

Navarra has a history of producing excellent, toothsome rosados and Monjardin's pink doesn't disappoint. Made by bleeding ripe Tempranillo grapes, it has a super salmon pink colour and a character stuffed with lush, ripe strawberry fruit. Clean and precise in the mouth, yet with an underlying richness, a terrific rosé with bags of flavour and personality.

3. Tanners French Rosé, Côtes de Gascogne, France

Bin No: MP0001B

Sourced from a family domaine in the Gers, this juicy, racy rosé has been a fantastic success since release. Vibrant summer fruits nose and a soft strawberry flavour mean one bottle isn't enough!

4. No 1 Rosé, Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence, Domaine Pey Blanc, France

Bin No: MP0045B

An attractive nose with white flowers and hints of exotic fruits leads to an elegant palate with red fruits and citrus flavours. From a family-owned and run estate close to Aix-en-Provence.

5. Les Cypres Rosé, Méditerranée, Pey Blanc, France

Bin No: MP0046B

A fresh, pale rosé with floral aromas and plenty of soft fruit such as plums, blackberries and white peaches on the palate. Perfect summer drinking.

6. Rosé d'Anjou, Les Martignolles, Château La Varière, France

Bin No: LP0006B

The bouquet is reminiscent of red berries (raspberries and strawberries). The palate is expressive, aromatic with a hint of cordial. The clean, fresh finish is balanced by a fine acidity.
