Press Reviews	<p>*Wine of the Week* Neuburger is an extremely rare grape, even in its native Austria, with only 550 of the country's 44,000 hectares, but Feiler-Artinger have made something of a specialty of the variety. This is wonderfully perfumed, with very understated oak, peachy, savoury, spicy flavours, plenty of weight and texture. It gives the impression of slight sweetness, but finishes dry, refreshing and well balanced. The estate now comprises 30 ha around Rust and the Hügelland, the chain of low hills to the west of the Neusiedlersee. The soils here are a mixture of slate, stones and chalk, and the climate is influenced by the shallow waters of the lake. Big and bold – very perfumed indeed!
