Colombard, Cotes de Gascogne, Vignerons de Plaimont 2018

Another success from Gascony where the Plaimont co-operative continues to deliver drop dead gorgeous whites. This is well made and fruity with the Colombard grape at its zesty and zingy best. Excellent value.



Château Le Fagé Sauvignon Blanc, Bergerac 2018

Fresh, elegant Sauvignon, bursting with elderflower, crisp refreshing acidity and grassy, herbaceous fruit. Winemaking at Château Le Fagé dates back to 1920, and Benoit Gérardin continues its tradition of great wines.



Domaine Rives-Blanques Chardonnay, Haute Vallée de l'Aude 2018

A cool climate, night harvested Chardonnay from Limoux, with dry, crisp fruit, freshness and intensity. The grapes are hand-picked from 750 metre-high vineyards within sight of the snow-capped Pyrenees, after which the estate is named.



Martinfort Carignan, Sélection Vieilles Vignes, Vin de France 2018

Round, full and soft red with good chunky fruit and excellent concentration. There are a lot of old Carignan vines in the south of France and from low yields they make wonderfully characterful wine.



Le Rouge Vigneron, Castelmaure, Corbières 2017

Full of juicy fruit, soft and easy style with herby weight and just a touch of tannin on the finish. From a quality driven co-operative.



Faugères, Les Jardins, Domaine Saint Antonin 2018

Liquorice and herb flavours with plenty of soft fruit and ripe tannins balanced with lovely freshness. Frédéric Albaret runs this 30 hectare estate.
