These wines are boxed in the traditional Bordeaux pine boxes with nailed down lids

JB Audy, the négociant company, have owned Château Courlat in Lussac-Saint-Emilion for several decades. Pierre Bourotte, grandson of Jean-Baptiste Audy, named this cuvée to honour his grandfather. Cuvée Jean-Baptiste is 100% Merlot, the average age of the vines is 25 years and uses 30% new oak, with the much-vaunted Michel Rolland is consultant. The wines have great concentration and depth, full of fruit, and they benefit from 10 years or more in bottle, although most is drunk young. This is a great opportunity to taste an excellent Bordeaux wine at various stages of maturity.
