Journey's End 'The Pastor's Blend' Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, Stellenbosch 2018

An attractive smoky fruit character on the nose, rich and plummy on the palate, this is juicy and very drinkable!



Meerlust 'Rubicon', Stellenbosch 2016

A Merlot and Cabernet blend, Rubicon is one of the Cape's leading claret-style wines. Complex, ripe, plummy flavours owe in part to cool afternoon breezes, a result of Meerlust being the closest Stellenbosch estate to the sea.



Acrux, Colchagua, Sutil 2015

A blend of many grape varieties, this is powerful wine with huge depth, concentration and complexity. Deep black and red berry fruit, fine tannins and a long finish.
