Description

This new release uses Tempranillo grown at 900 metres altitude in what is known as “El Monte Alto de Pesquera” or “The Highlands of Pesquera”. There is a freshness on the palate with an abundance of rich, dark fruit character, plenty of textbook silkiness and good structure. Aged for 14 months at the winery, in barrels of different capacities and medium toast, this is a first class, juicy Ribera for early drinking.
