Ancre Hill's vineyards are just outside Monmouth in Wales, planted by owners Richard and Joy Morris back in 2006. Since the release of their first wines a few years later they've been quietly winning fans and medals with their 'biodynamic' wines (super organic with added natural treatments in the vineyard).
